

Scripture reference: Going Home: The Ascension.

Story summary: Apostles see Jesus ascend to Heaven.

Optional Lesson Strengthening: Jelly Bean Poem (Jelly Bean Prayer). The Jelly Bean Prayer is a short, sweet poem that uses jelly bean colours to teach kids about Christ's sacrifice at the cross. Each colour represents part of God's story of redemption. Buy a packet of Jelly Beans to illustrate each line of the poem. To teach The Jelly Bean Prayer to your kids, start by reading it to them. As you read it aloud, show them a jelly bean of each colour as you share the symbolism of each one. As you teach the poem, be sure to stop and explain what each item means. For example, tell your kids, "Black is for our sin, the wrong things we do, because sin separates us from God. That's sad isn't it?"

Red is for the blood He gave.
 Green is for the grass He made.
 Yellow is for the sun so bright.
 Orange is for the edge of night.
 Black is for the sins we made.
 White is for the grace He gave.
 Purple is for His hour of sorrow.

Further discussion: Even though the disciples had been told by Jesus what to expect they were most likely frightened and overwhelmed when the things that Jesus said would happen were taking place. It would not have been easy to watch the innocent Son of God be treated like a criminal and be nailed to a Roman Cross. It was very traumatic and unsettling for Jesus' disciples. Sometimes feelings of fear, sadness, or loneliness can cloud our hearts to the truth that Jesus has spoken to us from His Word. The Bible is full of God's instructions for His people to follow until He returns or calls them home. When we have feelings that seem to overwhelm us we need to find out the truth from reading God's Word.

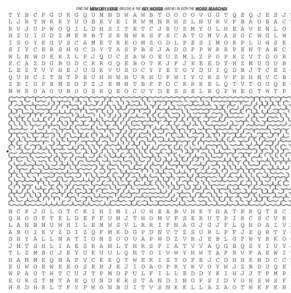

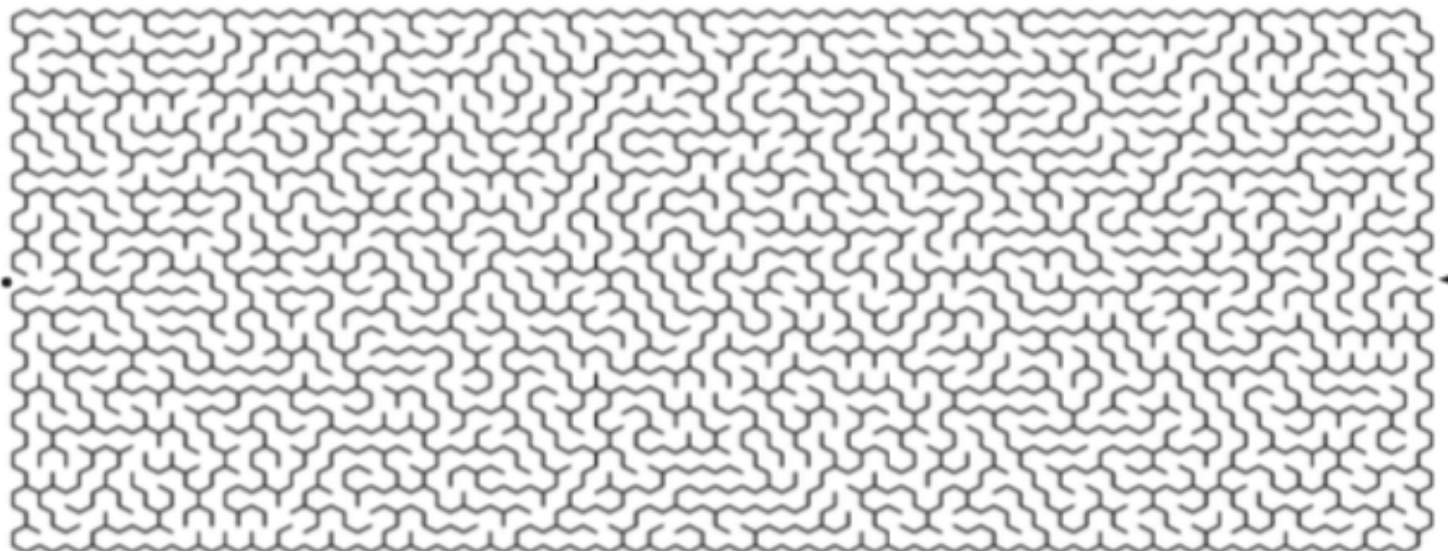
