

Scripture reference: The Terrible Lie: Adam and Eve lose everything.

Story summary: God made rules to protect us and that sin entered the world when people broke God's rules. Sin spoiled God's perfect creation. Sin also means we run away from God and try to be happy and live without God. Sin not only makes us and others sad and lonely and sick and afraid, it also breaks our relationship with God.

Optional Lesson Strengthening: Prepare a box with a mirror inside and cover it. Say: Last week we learnt about all the animals God made, who can name some animals God created (encourage response). Tell the kids you want to show a few of them what God's greatest creation is. Let them come up and look in the box, they will be pleasantly surprised to see a mirror showing them, THEMSELVES! Ask the kids who didn't get to look, what they think is in the box (encourage response). Encourage more children to look in the box but not say anything when they go sit down. Then show the whole group whats inside the box and discuss how God created everything, but that they as humans, are God's most special creation. Say: But as we heard today, God had one rule for us - to not eat the forbidden fruit - and we did. Because of sin, we now have a broken relationship with God.


Activities:

Further discussion: The story of Adam and Eve is a great reminder to everyone about what can happen when the rules are not obeyed. It might feel ok in the beginning, or for a short while afterward, to break the rules, but it never ends well. Adam and Eve knew that what they were doing was not right, and they knew the consequences, but still chose to disobey. This is fairly similar to how we operate in life; we usually know the consequences of our actions and still chose to disobey.





Cut the puzzle apart on the red lines, mix the pieces up, and put the picture back together.


