SUNDAY FELLOWSHIP GROUP GUIDE

SCRIPTURE REFERENCE:

The terrible lie. Adam and Eve lose everything from Genesis 3.

STORY SUMMARY:

God gave Adam and Eve one rule to obey: to not eat the fruit from this one tree. Because they ate the fruit (listened to the snake), sin entered the world. Sin spoiled God's perfect creation. Sin not only makes us and others sad and lonely and sick and afraid, it also breaks our relationship with God.

INTRODUCTION:

Last time we heard about all the things that God created, and it was perfect. But all that changed - when Adam and Eve ate the forbidden fruit. Adam and Eve now had a broken relationship with God, and so do we. But God made us a promise - He will mend our relationship with Him so that we can be with Him forever. How? By sending Jesus.

OPTIONAL LESSON STRENGTHENING:


Prepare a box with a mirror inside and cover it. Say: Last week we learnt about all the animals God made, who can name some animals God created (encourage response). Tell the kids you want to show a few of them what God's greatest creation is. Let them come up and look in the box, they will be pleasantly surprised to see a mirror showing them, THEMSELVES! Ask the kids who didn't get to look, what they think is in the box (encourage response). Encourage more children to look in the box but not say anything when they go sit down. Then show the whole group what's inside the box and discuss how God created everything, but that they as humans, are God's most special creation. Say: God made a promise to Adam and Eve. God promised He will battle the snake, and get rid of sin, and His people will never be sad or lonely or sick or afraid ever again. God will mend our relationship with him, so that we can be with Him forever. How does God do that? How does God solve the problem of sin? (encourage response), yes, by sending Jesus.




